## THE WINE

The traditional style of vinification favored along the Mosel has long produced Rieslings with a fine residual sweetness. The “Von Schiefer” feinherb continues this tradition and sets the stage for the mineral-rich, steep slope Riesling portfolio from Eva Clüsserath-Wittmann. Located on the Trittenheim side of the river, the weathered clayey slate soils of the Altärchen single-site vineyard lend the Riesling a bright fruitiness reminiscent of citrus, grapefruit and apples.

## VINIFICATION

Playful acidity and balanced sweetness dance together to delicate notes of apple peel and grapefruit, enhanced by fresh herbal accents. The entire symphony comes together in a balanced palate that is quintessentially Mosel.
