TASTING NOTES 2019 Trittenheimer APOTHEKE Riesling Auslese AC1913

THE WINE

The exceptional renommee of the Trittenheimer APOTHEKE vineyard comes in part from its unique combination of rocky slate subsoil and a relatively protected southwest exposition. The slate collects the warmth and releases it slowly over an extended period, which promotes good transformation of the acids by the vines. The result: delicate acidity mingling with a spicy, powerful minerality into the picture of liquid sophistication.

The APOTHEKE Auslese is a traditional dessert wine. The almost creamy texture and ripe fruit flavors on the palate are balanced with a complex minerality and marked acidity in its youth:

The sophisticated interplay of sweetness and acidity is enhanced with ripe, concentrated notes of ginger, blackberry, green rea and fine herbs. A lively acidity and elegant mineral expression lend the wine finesse and tremendous cellarability

VINIFICATION

As befits a premium wine, the grapes are always hand harvested and gently pressed. The must is then fermented using native yeasts in traditional Mosel fuder barrels and left on the lees until May.
