THE WINE

NEUMAGEN Rosengärtchen is situated between Trittenheim and Piesport. The vineyards are next to the famous site Trittenheimer APOTHEKE and Neumagener SONNENUHR. Vinified in the pristine sweet style for which the Mosel is renowned, the NEUMAGEN Rosengärtchen Spätlese shows intense fruit aromas of mango, some pepper and camille, mingling with accents of candied orange. This complex range of fruits is further complemented with minerality and a persistent acidity.

VINIFICATION

As befits a premium wine, the grapes are always hand harvested and gently pressed. The must is then fermented using native yeasts in traditional Mosel fuder barrels and left on the lees until May.
